Please write a comment of three pages (double-spaced, 2.5 cm margin) on a scientific or clinical publication of your choice pertaining to the topic of one of the sessions; relate the argument critically to the lecture and possibly the main reading for that session. Please critically weigh arguments against each other. 2. Please write critical comments (1-2 paragraphs, **at least 7 sentences**) in the OLAT discussion forum regarding 2 lectures which are different from the one you wrote task #1 on.

Please mail the latest on July 20 an integrated document (word) containing both task 1 and 2 (comments in the forum with publication date, **and the publication you discuss in for task 1**).
